# **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. JUNIOR (A) CATEGORY: Born after September 30, 2008 (under 18 years of age).
- **2.** SENIOR (B) CATEGORY: Born between September 30, 1998 and September 30, 2008 (between 18-28 years of age).
- **3.** Those born in 2008 may apply to compete in any category they wish.



**4.** Not having won first place in our previous Cahit Koparal Flute Competitions.

#### **PARTICIPATION METHOD:**

- 1. PRELIMINARY SELECTION: YouTube video recording
- a. Competitors must complete the application form on the MAKSAD website (www.maksad.org).
- b. Separate video recordings of one Baroque period piece, either solo or accompanied, and two (2) separate pieces (maximum 5 minutes each) of their choice must be uploaded to their own YouTube channels, and the YouTube links must be included in the Preliminary Competition application form.
- c. Audio and video manipulation and editing of the Preliminary Competition video recording will not be accepted.
- d. The video must be recorded so that the competitor's face and hands are clearly visible.
- e. For phone recordings, the camera must be horizontal and close to the competitor.
- f. Preliminary Competition video recording links must be uploaded and submitted to the application form at https://maksad.org/en/competition/ by the evening of March 13, 2026.
- g. The pre-selection evaluation of the competition will be conducted by the Competition Jury Members.
- h. The list of contestants who passed the pre-selection will be announced on the MAKSAD website on March 27, 2026, and notification will also be provided by email.
- 2. Contestants who passed the pre-selection must deposit the application registration fee in the amount of 60 Euros to the Marmaris Culture and Arts Association Euro (€) account below, or in the amount of 60 Euros in Turkish Lira to the Turkish Central Bank (TCMB) exchange rate on the transaction date. Bank transfer and swift transaction expenses are the responsibility of the contestant.
